
Removing seat subframe and runners

To get the subframe(s) off, you simply need to undo the two Torx bolts at the back of each runner - shown <u>here</u>



To get the runners off, you need to remove the seat base cloth and foam. Start by freeing up the <u>back</u>



with a screwdriver/pliers, then

pulling



that through to the front and then

working round the base



until it is free.

There are then <u>four nuts</u>



to undo, which hold the runners to the base. Strangely, just on one runner, there is also a single

<u>rivet</u>



It might be possible to drill out, but is has been known to spin, so you may need to hacksaw through it.
